Directions: Print the tangram blocks on the following page. Directions are on the page to create the blocks. Print on cardstock paper. You must make the blocks two sided. OPTION #1: Print and glue to foam board. Use a craft knife to cut apart the cards to make heavy duty blocks.

OPTION #2: Print on magnetic paper and use on a metal tray (i.e. cookie sheet, lunch box, etc.) or whiteboard/refridgerator to solve the puzzles.


Work on one puzzle card at a time. Use the tangram blocks to create the objects, animals and people.

TANGRAMS


Cut out rectangle.
